- Dramatic re-telling of the Gospel of St Mark on Sunday 17 March at 4pm at St Jesus Christ our Lord. Mary's Westfield. The event falls into two halves of 45 minutes each, with a break in-between for refreshments.
- Soup Lunch on Wednesday 20 March at St Gregory's after the midday Mass, in support of CAFOD
- Lenten Scripture Group on Wednesday 20 March at St Gregory's at 7.15pm, a prayerful reading of the Gospel.
- Our Parish Lenten Reconciliation Service with Adoration and the opportunity for individual Confession at 6.30pm at St Gregory's on Thursday 21 March. Lent is nothing if it is not about repentance and conversion, and the Lord Himself gives us the opportunity to rid ourselves of all the weights that we bear in life through this beautiful sacrament of Confession. Even if it has been years and years since your last Confession, or you think you have forgotten what you are meant to do, do yourself a favour and let the Lord release you from your woes.
